- > **67 Members from Germany (manufactures, retailers, bioenergy sector)**

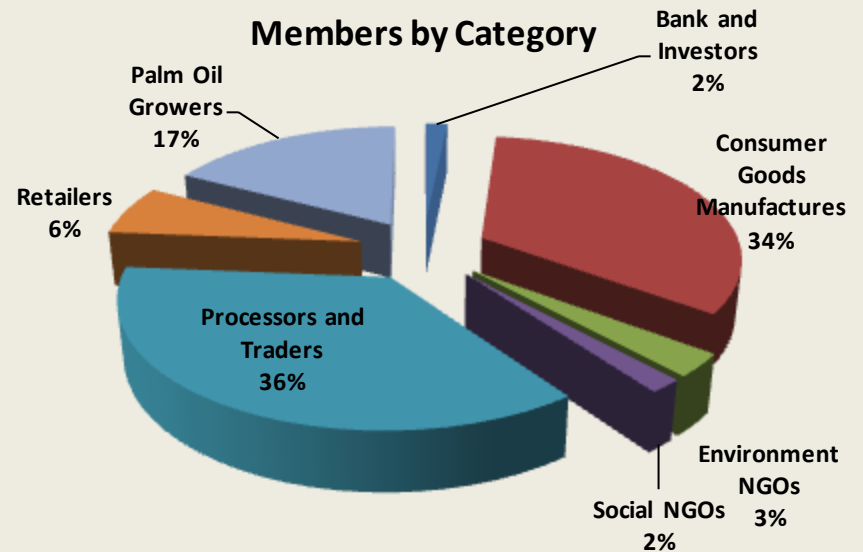
Vision Statement:

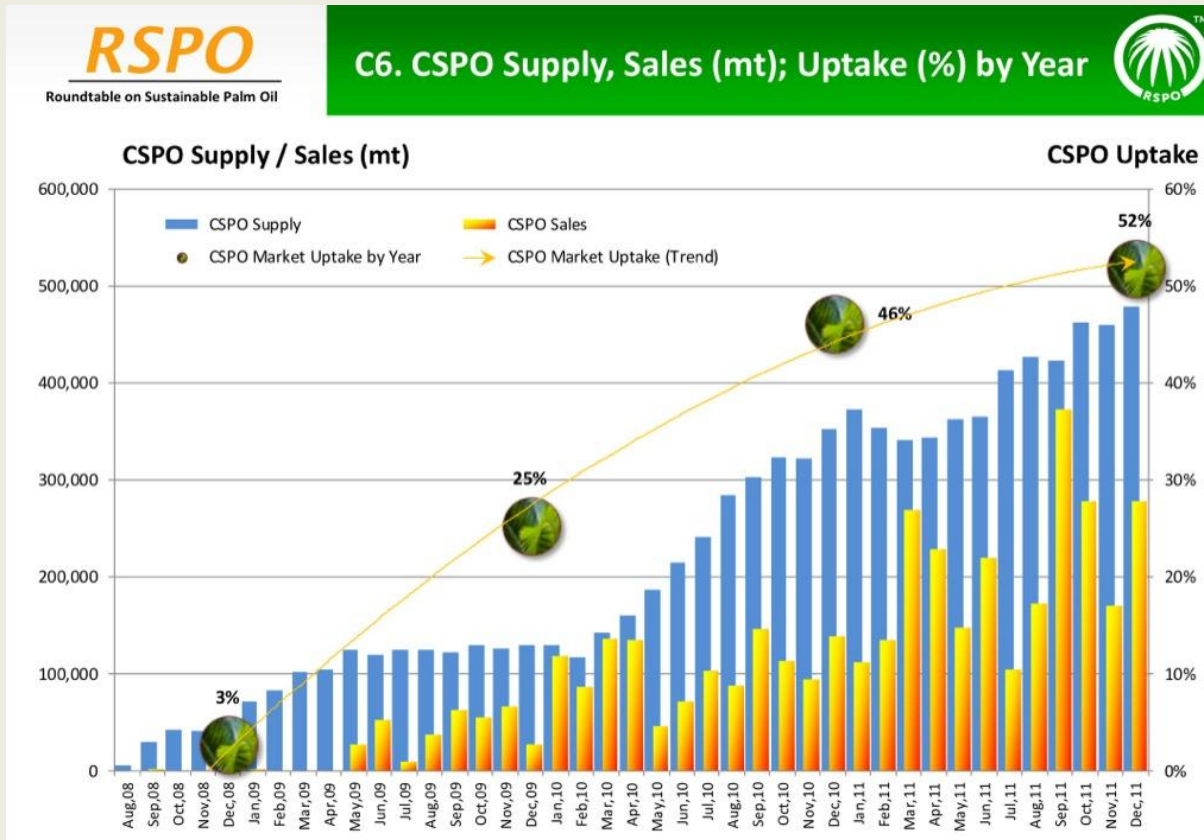

- 1,296 mt Certified Palm kernel Oil



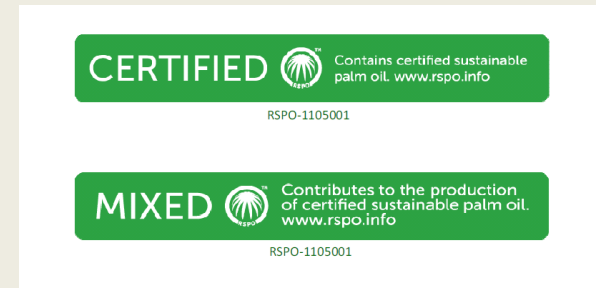
New Trademark

Application possible only for **members** using one of the three supply chains:

Identity Preserved, Segregation or Mass Balance

Trademark can only be used in communication directly linked to compliant product

Use is free at least until July 2012

 - Phase 2: Improving effectiveness of Principle & Criteria

All changes will be voted on by General Assembly 2012

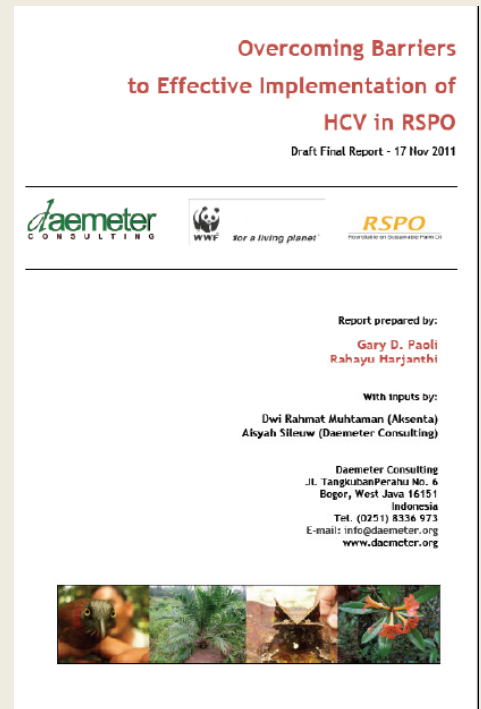


Improvement of High Conservation Value Assessments (HCV)

HCV right tool for RSPO

Study recommendations:

- Simplify and sharpen HCV tool
- Guidance on M&M requirements
- Increase capacity of assessors
- Transparency in reporting



Support of Smallholder Certification

Improvement of documents

- National Interpretation RSPO Standard for Smallholders
- Group certification for SH
- Guidance for training facilitators

RSPO has applied for recognition by EU Commission, Recognition expected within next months.

RSPO: Now ready for bioenergy market

Scorecard Objectives

- Quantify breadth of global corporate commitments to sustainable palm oil, highlighting leading companies
- Assess each company individually against a set of criteria
- Raise awareness of RSPO and CSPO amongst key palm oil using companies
- Raise awareness amongst consumers of the negative impacts of palm oil and the positive solution provided by RSPO

- Active member of the RSPO?
- Public commitment to RSPO-certified sustainable palm oil?
- Disclosing how much palm oil is used?
- Showing how much of the palm oil they source is RSPO-certified?



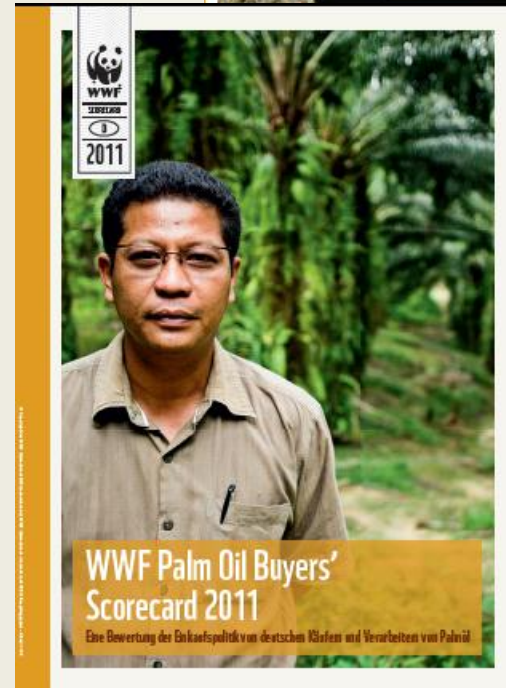
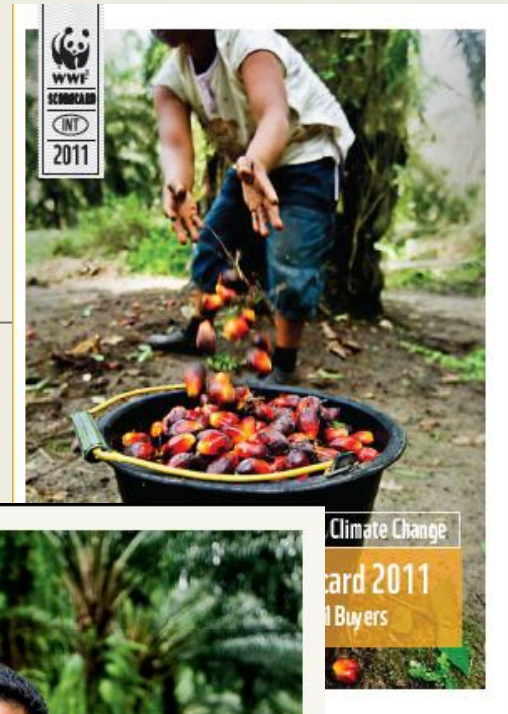
Scorecards 2011

International Scorecards:

WWF has assessed again the palm oil buying practices of **132 retailers and manufacturers** → Scope of Scorecard includes companies from **Europe**, but also from **Australia and Japan**

National Scorecards

WWF has assessed **64 retailers and manufacturers** in the **German market**





Results for Germany

Basis: 64 companies, about 800.000 t palm oil)

- 50 % are already using certified palm oil
- 28 companies have given a timebound commitment
- Two companies got 9 points and five companies 8 points

**Companies need to shift gears immediately and
accelerate their use of RSPO-certified palm oil**



RSPO

- Multistakeholder: Developed and owned by the players in the chain
- Credible and Transparent
- Complaint mechanism & grievance panel
- Independent verification mechanism
- (third party certification)
- One standard for Food, Feed and Fuel
- Ready for biofuel market
